Dr. Jing Liu received her medical degree from Beijing Medical University in 1993 and did her fellowship training in the Center for Human Nutrition, University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas.

Dr. Liu is currently a member of the executive board of International Atherosclerosis Society (IAS), a fellow of the European Society of Cardiology (ESC), and a member of the Preventive Cardiology Committee in the Chinese Preventive Medicine Association (CPMA) and the Chinese College of Cardiovascular Physicians (CCCCP).

Dr. Liu's research interests include the risk factors of atherosclerosis, surveillance of cardiovascular disease, and quality care for cardiovascular disease. She has been a key investigator of the Sino-MONICA project and the Chinese Multi-provincial Cohort Study (CMCS). She is now the PI of the Multi-provincial Cohort of Hypertension (MUCH) - a project from the National Key Research and Development Program of China and several epidemiological studies on cardiovascular diseases. She has published more than 100 papers in Chinese journals and 60 papers in international journals, including the *Lancet*, *JAMA*, *JACC*, *Circulation*, and some other top SCI journals.
